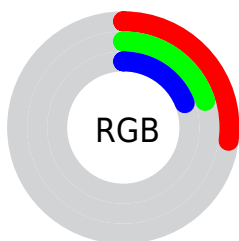

Details

The CIELCh color **23, 9.110, 33.561** is a dark color, and the websafe version is hex **333333**. A complement of this color would be **26, 7.536, 213.444**, and the grayscale version is **23, 0.004, 296.813**.

A 20% lighter version of the original color is **43, 9.318, 31.561**, and **3, 8.832, 32.599** is the 20% darker color. If you saturate the color by 10%, you get **21, 12.544, 34.012**, and if you desaturate by 10%, it is **25, 5.905, 33.269**.

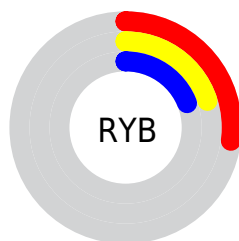

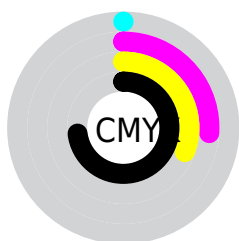

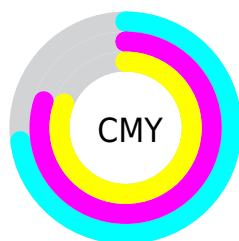

Brightness & Saturation Gradients

These gradients show how the CIELCh color 23, 9.110, 33.561 changes by changing the brightness by 10 percent. The first figure shows a shift by +10% for each color and the second figure -10%.

Similar to the brightness gradients but the following saturation gradients show a change of the CIELCh color 23, 9.110, 33.561 by changing the saturation by 10% instead.

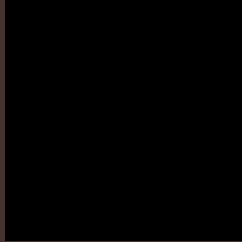

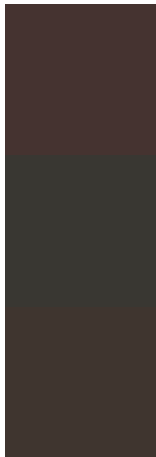


This preview shows how white text looks on a background with the CIELCh color 23, 9.110, 33.561.

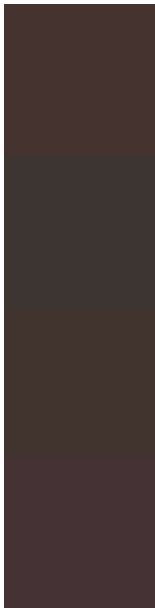

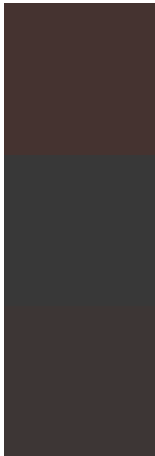

Text

The CSS property to change the color of the text to CIELCh 23, 9.110, 33.561 is called "color". The color property can be set on classes, ids or directly on the HTML element.

This example shows how text in the color `rgb(69, 51, 48)` looks like.

```
.text, #text, p{  
    color:rgb(69, 51, 48)  
}
```

If you want to add a text shadow in that color use the text-shadow property, you can generate a text shadow directly with our [CSS Text Shadow Generator](#).

Here you see how black text with a 4 pixel rgb(69, 51, 48) colored shadow looks like.

```
.shadow{ text-shadow: 4px 4px 2px rgb(69, 51, 48) }
```

Border

The CSS property to change the border of an element to CIELCh 23, 9.110, 33.561 is called "border". The border property can be set on classes, ids or directly on the HTML element.

This example shows the color as border, it can be applied via the CSS property "border" or "border-color".

```
.border, #border, table{ border:4px solid rgb(69, 51, 48) }
```

If only the border color should be changed use the property border-color.

```
.border{ border-color:rgb(69, 51, 48) }
```

If you want to add a box shadow in that color use:

.background, #background, body{  
background: rgb(69, 51, 48) }
```

If only the background color should be changed can be used:

```
.background{ background-color: rgb(69, 51,  
48) }
```
