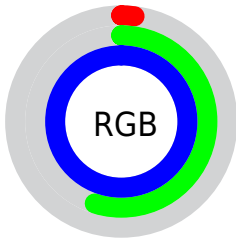

Details

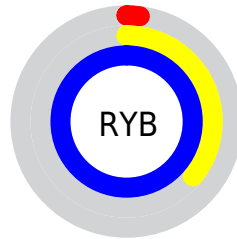
The CIELCh color **58, 66.551, 279.974** is a dark color, and the websafe version is hex **3399FF**. The color can be described as dark saturated azure. A complement of this color would be **66, 86.079, 57.180**, and the grayscale version is **47, 0.006, 296.813**.

A 20% lighter version of the original color is **75, 38.669, 259.186**, and **40, 64.402, 287.788** is the 20% darker color. If you saturate the color by 10%, you get **57, 67.876, 280.911**, and if you desaturate by 10%, it is **62, 60.160, 275.149**.

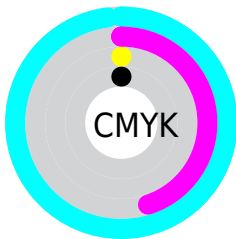

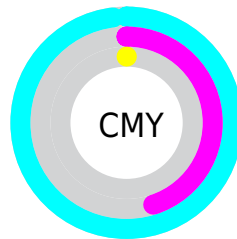

Brightness & Saturation Gradients


These gradients show how the CIELCh color 58, 66.551, 279.974 changes by changing the brightness by 10 percent. The first figure shows a shift by +10% for each color and the second figure -10%.


Similar to the brightness gradients but the following saturation gradients show a change of the CIELCh color 58, 66.551, 279.974 by changing the saturation by 10% instead.

The Complementary color scheme is a pair of colors which are on the opposite of each other on the color wheel.



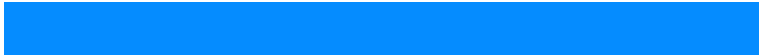

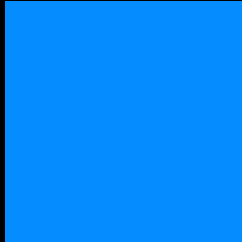

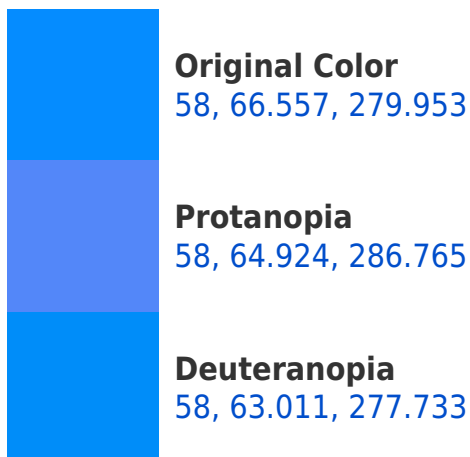


This preview shows how white text looks on a background with the CIELCh color 58, 66.551, 279.974.

CSS Examples

Text

The CSS property to change the color of the text to CIELCh 58, 66.551, 279.974 is called "color". The color property can be set on classes, ids or directly on the HTML element.

This example shows how text in the color `rgb(5, 140, 255)` looks like.

```
.text, #text, p{  
    color:rgb(5, 140, 255)  
}
```

If you want to add a text shadow in that color use the text-shadow property, you can generate a text shadow directly with our [CSS Text Shadow Generator](#).

Here you see how black text with a 4 pixel rgb(5, 140, 255) colored shadow looks like.

```
.shadow{ text-shadow: 4px 4px 2px rgb(5, 140, 255) }
```

Border

The CSS property to change the border of an element to CIELCh 58, 66.551, 279.974 is called "border". The border property can be set on classes, ids or directly on the HTML element.

This example shows the color as border, it can be applied via the CSS property "border" or "border-color".

```
.border, #border, table{ border:4px solid rgb(5, 140, 255) }
```

If only the border color should be changed use the property `border-color`.

```
.border{ border-color:rgb(5, 140, 255) }
```

If you want to add a box shadow in that color use:

Here you see how a box with a 4 pixel `rgb(5, 140, 255)` colored shadow looks like.

If only the background color should be changed can be used:

.background{ background-color: rgb(5, 140,  
255) }
```
