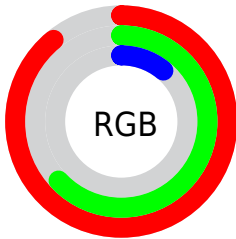

# Details

The HunterLab color **64.7337, 9.7895, 39.0537** is a dark color, and the websafe version is hex **CC9900**. The color can be described as middle washed orange. A complement of this color would be **37.1464, 23.1564, -92.6990**, and the grayscale version is **61.8234, -3.2987, 3.3590**.

A 20% lighter version of the original color is **84.3167, -4.4457, 45.2318**, and **43.8849, 9.8456, 27.2140** is the 20% darker color. If you saturate the color by 10%, you get **62.6752, 13.2875, 38.7086**, and if you desaturate by 10%, it is **66.9106, 6.6121, 38.6003**.

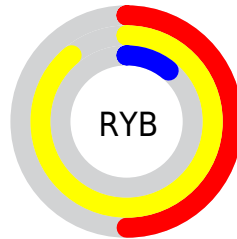

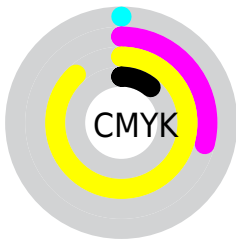

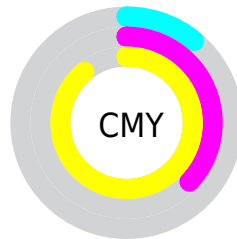

# Brightness & Saturation Gradients

These gradients show how the HunterLab color 64.7337, 9.7895, 39.0537 changes by changing the brightness by 10 percent. The first figure shows a shift by +10% for each color and the second figure -10%.

Similar to the brightness gradients but the following saturation gradients show a change of the HunterLab color 64.7337, 9.7895, 39.0537 by changing the saturation by 10% instead.

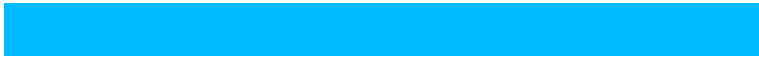

## Border
